A Visit from the Zoo!

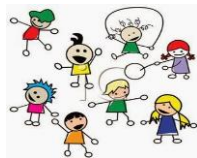

Dear Holy Cross Parents:

I am fortunate to be part of the Holy Cross Catholic Preschool and Center community again this school year. I will strive to be a consistent presence in your school, addressing the developmental, emotional and behavioral needs of your children.

For those of you who I have not had the pleasure of meeting, here is some background information about **myself. I received my Ph.D. in clinical child psychology at the University of Miami. Upon receiving my degree,** I worked at the Center for Child Development in West Palm Beach. I opened my own private practice in April 2007. I conduct developmental and psychological evaluations with children and their families; offer child and family therapy; and consultations with families regarding emotional and/or behavioral concerns. My specialty areas include, but are not limited to, autism spectrum disorders, disruptive behavior problems, social inhibition or “shyness,” developmental delay and attention problems. Although I focus on clinical populations, I have also worked with parents on a variety of “non-clinical” issues such as problems with sharing, sibling rivalry, and biting and temper tantrums.

It is a pleasure for me to be able to work with the staff, parents and children at Holy Cross Catholic Preschool and Center. During the present school year, I will be consulting with parents and teachers; observing children in their classrooms; conducting brief evaluations and providing behavioral intervention training to parents and teachers. **We invite you to attend a “Meet and Greet” at Holy Cross Catholic Preschool and Center on Tuesday, September 25th from 8:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.** At this time, I will meet you and answer any questions you may have about my role at your child’s school. Also, please be advised that I will be conducting observations in all classrooms during the month of October.

I look forward to meeting many of you and becoming a part of your community!
